

Licensing Text

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Overview

In general, two types of licensing text insertions are needed:

1. At the beginning of each code file, a license claim block is to be added in the language specific comment format;
2. At the root of each repo, a LICENSES.txt file is added to provide umbrella coverage for the repo.

Depends on which charter a repo belongs to, below lists the specific text blocks to be used in different situations.
