- No major update.
- Still training & initial prototyping around rApp execution platform - k8s based.
 - Nothing to show yet. Getting closer. Will share in coming weeks.
- ONAP H release - A1 Policy Functions - getting over the line! (Warnings in gating tests, Documentation, etc)

SIM ([Alex Stancu](#))

- No major update.
- Continuing with [Core Infrastructure Initiative \(CII\)](#) [Badging](#) tasks.

OAM ([Martin Skorupski](#))

- Still discussing topology in ONAP: [Abstract Topology Model](#)
 - Also getting interest from optical transport people (in ONAP ?) too!
- O-RAN specs from "November train" now available from O-RAN website
 - Reviewing models with [Alex Stancu](#). Working on CI pipeline testing etc of models ... will revert to O-RAN Alliance
- Preparing O-DU use-case prototype model
